The School of Continuing Studies Bursary

Information

Definition

The School of Continuing Studies Bursary was established in 2012 to support individuals wanting to enroll in University of Toronto School of Continuing Studies courses* but who are unable to do so due to financial challenges.

Value

A limited number of bursaries with a value of up to \$750.00 will be awarded annually.

Eligibility

- Students with current outstanding debts to the School of Continuing Studies are not eligible.
- Students who qualify for other financial assistance programs (e.g. OSAP) are not eligible.
- Students may only apply/reapply for one bursary per term (Fall, Winter or Spring).
- Proof of income (e.g., Income Tax Return Verification; most recent Notice of Assessment; government approved proof of unemployment, disabilities, etc.) will be required of each student, including members of your family AT THE TIME you apply.
- Students must be residents of Ontario for at least one year at the time of applying.
- Bursaries cannot be used in conjunction with any promotional discounts, including the OBPAP bursary.

Selection Criteria

Applications will be evaluated and ranked according to the following criteria:

- 1. Demonstration of financial need (see proof of income above).
- 2. Degree to which funding will assist with achieving the objectives described in the student's learning ambitions.

Application Procedures

Bursary applications must be completed in full and include pertinent financial documentation. It is expected that all information provided on bursary applications and subsequent discussions will be truthful and accurate. If there is evidence of misrepresentation of financial circumstances, bursary assistance will be refused or withdrawn.

Please mail in or drop off applications. We cannot guarantee that your application will be accepted. If you meet the criteria, and funds are available, you will be notified by email or phone within 2 -3 weeks of submitting the application form. Once approved for a bursary you will be asked to pay the balance of the course costs in full upon registration. Students who register and pay for courses prior to being notified of a bursary approval are not eligible to receive a course refund.
