## Activities

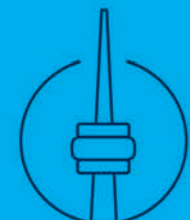
Visit world-famous Niagara Falls, watch a Toronto Blue Jays baseball game, go camping in the wilderness, or visit one of the city's many museums.

### ACADEMIC ENGLISH

Improve your prospects for admission to the University of Toronto or other English-language universities or colleges — and for success once you are in. This course will provide you with the opportunity to meet the English language facility requirement and help you build the confidence you need to excel in an academic environment. You will strengthen your skills in academic reading, writing, listening, and speaking. During the course, you will also have access to the libraries, computers, events, and many services at the University of Toronto.

A grade of B or higher at Level 60 in Academic English satisfies the English language facility requirement for admission to undergraduate and most graduate programs at the University of Toronto. Some other universities and colleges also accept this as proof of language facility.
