

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ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAM REGISTRATION POLICIES

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To join the University of Toronto English Language Program (ELP), you must be at least 17 years old and have some basic understanding of English. Our programs are not suitable for complete beginners in English. Some programs require you to be at an intermediate level of English facility or to meet other requirements. The ELP reserves the right to deny entrance to students not fulfilling these requirements.

VISAS & STUDY PERMITS

It is your responsibility to register for ELP programs in sufficient time to apply for and receive your Canadian visa or study permit.

For further information regarding the type of visa or study permits you may require, please see: elp.learn.utoronto.ca/beforeyou-arrive

If you plan to visit the United States during your stay in Canada, check with the US embassy or consulate in your country. You must get your US visa before you come to Canada.

You must assume complete responsibility for your personal financial needs.

If your application is refused, you may be able to obtain a refund of fees paid to the ELP, subject to certain conditions (see the policy on Visa & Study Permit Refusal).

FEES

All programs and service fees are quoted in Canadian dollars and cover the cost of tuition, program materials, and the required health fees.

Tuition and health fees must be paid in full at time of registration. All ELP students (international students, immigrants and Canadian citizens) are required to pay the same tuition. Tuition and health fees may be paid in the following ways:

- by credit card (Visa, Mastercard and American Express)
- •by official bank-certified cheque/money order, in Canadian funds, payable to the

University of Toronto. Cash, personal cheques, and wire transfers will not be accepted.

TUITION FEE

The Tuition Fee includes assigned textbooks, class materials, and several events and activities. Additional activities are offered for a minimal fee.

HEALTH INSURANCE, KEEP.MESAFE AND HEALTH SERVICES FEE

The Health Insurance, Keep.MeSafe and Health Services Fee includes:

- a health plan with comprehensive medical coverage
- 24-hour access to a mental health counselling service
- full use of the University of Toronto Student Health and Services and the University's Medical Clinic

ELP students are expected to speak only English in the classroom and lobby, and during activities.

PROGRAM CANCELLATION

The ELP reserves the right to cancel any program because of insufficient registration. You will be refunded all fees you have paid for the cancelled program.

PROGRAM SCHEDULING CHANGES

The ELP reserves the right to adjust the timing of all program.

TRANSFERS

Session Transfer

If you do not receive your visa or study permit in time for the program start date or your plans change, your full tuition can be transferred to any other session within one year of the original registration. Please submit written notice before the last date for withdrawal with refund to Enrolment & Learner Services at learn@utoronto.ca (see Schedule for Refunds).

Program Change

You can change from one program to another if:

• the program you are registered for does not meet your needs or your plans change and

 you speak with a Program Coordinator and get signed permission, and you do so by the last date for withdrawal with refund.

VISA & STUDY PERMIT REFUSAL

If you must cancel your registration because Canadian Immigration has denied your visa or study permit, your full tuition and health fees will be refunded if:

 Enrolment & Learner Services is notified in writing at learn@utoronto.ca prior to the first day of classes that you will not be attending; and,

• Enrolment & Learner Services receives the original letter issued by the Canadian Embassy/High Commission confirming that the study permit was denied. Enrolment & Learner Services must receive the documents prior to the program start date.

LIABILITY WAIVER
