The Ogilvie Award for Excellence in Project Management

2019 APPLICATION FORM

Definition

Project management professional and award-winning instructor Joseph Ogilvie established this award in 2015 to recognize and reward professionals registered in the School's Project Management Certificate Programs who have contributed to growth, innovation, and overall organizational success.

Value

The Ogilvie Award for Excellence in Project Management is valued at \$2,500 annually.

Eligibility

Applicants will be required to:

- Have successfully completed a minimum of any two courses in any project management certificate program* at the University of Toronto School of Continuing Studies with a minimum B (70%) average.
- Be in good financial standing with the University of Toronto School of Continuing Studies.

Selection Criteria

PROJECT PLAN: Applicants will be required to provide a compelling 15 slide (max) document that includes the following:

- A high-level description of their organization and how it creates value for its customers.
- A clear description of a project that was successfully delivered and that was aligned with the organization's strategic plan OR had a strong contribution to organizational success and/or growth.
- An outline of how the project was identified, selected, and its resulting impact.
- A summary of the applicant's role and involvement in the project and of how their efforts contributed to its success. Include examples of how innovative or entrepreneurial approaches to the project, alongside tried and proven project management methods/practices, contributed to the project's overall success.

Submissions will be evaluated based on the demonstrated application of project management skills to meet a need and create demonstrable impact on an organization.

LETTER OF SUPPORT: Applicants must submit one letter of support from an employer or client verifying their project involvement and their accomplishments.

Application Procedures

Applicants must formally apply at the U of T School of Continuing Studies at 158 St. George Street, Toronto, ON M5S 2V8, or by email to Ben Wood at benjamin.wood@utoronto.ca. Completed application forms must be received by May 31st, 2019. The winner will be determined in the summer and the prize money will be given at an award ceremony in the fall.

* Students must have completed a minimum of any two courses in one of the following certificate programs: Project Management, Advanced Project Management, Agile Project Management, Applied Project Management, International Project management, Project Management Essentials
